Changes to Petersburg Route and New Service to Wal-Mart

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) is pleased to announce the addition of a run that will go to Wal-Mart in Taylor beginning on Monday, Feb. 28. This schedule, called “South Main Ave.,” will run Monday through Friday only, with the first trip leaving Wyoming Ave. at 7:05 a.m. and running every hour until 5:05 p.m. The last bus will leave Wal-Mart at 5:25 p.m.

This route runs along South Main Avenue and can stop at Gerrity’s Supermarket. The bus will pull into the parking lots of Price Chopper and Wal-Mart on the outbound route. It will not pull into Price Chopper’s parking lot on the return trip to downtown Scranton.

The Old Forge/Sibley route will not change at this time.

Additionally, COLTS is announcing that as of Monday, Feb. 28, the Petersburg bus will bypass Colfax Avenue and instead turn onto Arthur Ave. due to the congestion of school buses and cars near Audubon Elementary School.
