COLTS to hold “Stuff the Bus” Toy Drive on Tuesday

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will hold a Toy Drive called “Stuff the Bus” to benefit the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Foundation on Tuesday, Dec. 7, 2010.

People can drop off new, unwrapped toys and books at the COLTS Trolley on the Spruce Street side of Courthouse Square near the bus shelter from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monetary donations will also be accepted.

“We at COLTS talked about it and felt that we could really do something good to help our community by having this Toy Drive,” said Executive Director Bob Fiume. “We have been doing our weekly food drives on our buses, so we know the people in Lackawanna County are generous. We’re really hoping that they come out in big numbers to literally ‘stuff the bus’.” COLTS partnered with Marine Wing Support Squadron 472 Detachment Wyoming, which serves Lackawanna, Luzerne, Susquehanna, Wyoming, Sullivan, Tioga, Bradford, and Potter counties and helped 22,000 children in this multi-county area in 2009.
