COLTS to provide service to Monroe County via Mount Airy Casino Resort

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will begin trial-based service to Monroe County via Mount Airy Casino Resort on Tuesday, July 6, 2010. COLTS will offer three trips daily running Monday through Friday. The fare for a one-way trip is \$5, and senior citizens always ride free. Buses will depart from 101 Wyoming Ave., near Diversified Records and the donut shop.

COLTS passengers can get out at Mt. Airy and try their luck at the casino, or they can travel on to Monroe County via bus service provided by Monroe County Transportation Authority, said Executive Director Bob Fiume. The Crossings Premium Outlets at Tannersville, the Stroud Mall, and restaurants and shops in downtown Stroudsburg, East Stroudsburg and Mt. Pocono are popular destinations for COLTS passengers. Passengers can also get to the Delaware Water Gap Borough and National Recreation Area via MCTA buses. The MCTA fare is \$1.25.
